

## How to Lead a Child to Christ

Hopefully, you get the chance to lead a child to Christ while at Kidz Kamp. If you do, here's some tips from Bro. Dan Kerr, as well as an outline for how to work your way through that conversation!

### Tips for leading a child to Christ

- Make sure to talk to them one on one.
  - o If you have multiple children that would like to talk, have one sit aside and wait.
- Try not to use yes or no questions.
  - o Children can read your face and determine what you like for them to answer. They have already been reading their parents faces for years.
- Let them pray in their own words

### If the child wants to get saved, here's an outline of a conversation you can have with them

1. Let them know that the reason Jesus died was to pay for their sins.

Have you ever sinned? Yes/No Question. But follow it up with another questions.

What is one thing you have done wrong that is a sin?

2. A–B–C of Salvation: Try to have these verses memorized before you come to camp.

A – Admit to God that you have sinned!

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.

B – Believe that Jesus died on the cross for me and my sins.

I Cor. 15:3b-4 "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, & that He was buried, & that he rose again the third day according to the Scriptures."

C – Confess to Jesus that you need him to forgive you and trust Him to be your Savior.

John 1:12 "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

3. Have the children pray and tell Jesus what they would like to do. Let child pray in their own words.

If they're not sure what to say? Then have child tell you what they want to do. If they child shows an understanding of the gospel then say "Perfect, now tell God what you just told me."

4. Once the child prays, then you pray and thank God for saving the camper.

5. Lead the child to go share with at least one person what they have done.
